








TABLISHING INTERNET CONNECTION

Use Ethernet cable to to connect Modem directly to your PC or laptop




L connect several computers or other smart devices to the Internet by using one modem and additional Ethernet cables - Wired Network



CONNECTING TO WiFi in Munich City, Bavaria

Sometimes libraries, cafes, and schools offer free Wi-Fi for their patrons, customers, and students.

Ask your friend or a local person to help you find an internet cafe or a library where you can connect to the Internet. Munich City offers free WiFi in such places as:







USING BROWSERS: DOWNLOADING


- Your browser can display many different types of documents, media, and other files. Downloading enables you to do this by putting the file on your computer so you can access it.
- You can right-click the link and select Save Target As. You'll be able to choose the folder where the file is saved. Use <u>ONLY</u> secure websites!





USING BROWSERS: CREATING

BOOKMARKS




- ➤ Create

 Bookmarks of the visited websites in your browser
- ➤ You can return to the visited web pages without the need of saving the whole HTML page or downloading much content.
- ➤ Edit or delete your bookmarks any time




USING BROWSERS: BROWSING HISTORY



You can also check your browsing history by following the three parallel bricks in the right corner of a browser and clicking on the *History* option.




■Make sure a website is secure, including checking the SSL certificate e.g., when you are using banking websites
 ■Check the following:



- ■Web addresses either begin with http or https
- ■The browser will use a security symbol or lock
- □Click on the lock icon of the website and make sure the identity of the website is verified




Cookies




- to identify users and possibly prepare customized Web pages stores the information about you in your browser for later use, e.g. log in to your email or facebook accounts etc.;
- used to track browsing history which means that the next time you go to the same Web site, your browser will send the cookie to the Web server.


BASICS of the WEB SECURITY: Pop-Ups




- to block advertisements, malware and other damaging content on the web

IT IS VERY IMPORTANT TO PROTECT ANY PERSONAL INFORMATION!!!

Using internet sometimes requires sharing personal information if using:

- email accounts;
- social networks, e.g. facebook;
- professional networks, e.g. LinkedIn, XING;
- shopping, e.g. Amazon, eBay and other online shops;
- cloud services for businesses;
- financial operations, e.g. online banking;
- etc.



Strong passwords:

- Never use personal information, e.g. date of birth, parents' or spouses' names, pets' names etc;
- ➤ Use a longer password;
- ➤ If you need to write down your passwords, keep them in a secure place; NEVER share your passwords with anyone!
- ➤ Don't use the same password for each account;
- ➤ Try to include numbers, symbols, and both uppercase and lowercase letters if the site allows it:
- Avoid using commonly used words and simple patterns e.g. "save the planet", "happy Tom", 123456789 or similar;
- ➤ Random passwords are strong e.g., H=jNp2#

You can ask a website to remove your information. Keep in mind that websites are not always obligated to comply with your request. If the information posted about you is a direct threat to your safety and you need help negotiating with a website to remove the content, you can contact





Change your password frequently using the Account Settings

→ Send a request to Reset your password by using your another alternative account (usually email) if you have forgotten your password!
